NEWARK -- The Licking County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities (LCBMRDD) recently recognized Donna Flack as Staff Member of the Month for September.

Flack is director of Transportation Services for the LCBMRDD. She coordinates bus and van routes for adults who work at LICCO Inc. and children who attend preschool classes at the E.S. Weiant Center. She was nominated by members of her staff.

"She is a very respected supervisor," her nomination states. "She has a great team behind her. She has instilled in all of us (the desire) to work as a team."

Flack lives in Newark and has worked for the LCBMRDD for 23 years.

The LCBMRDD provides comprehensive services to more than 1,300 Licking County children and adults with mental retardation and developmental disabilities. The agency currently operates preschool and early intervention services at the E.S. Weiant Center in Newark; early intervention services at the Ann Davino Center in Pataskala; adult services at LICCO Inc. in Heath; residential supports; family respite; transportation services; and service coordination.

The LCBMRDD is nationally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for providing high-quality support services to individuals with disabilities and their families.
