From the North

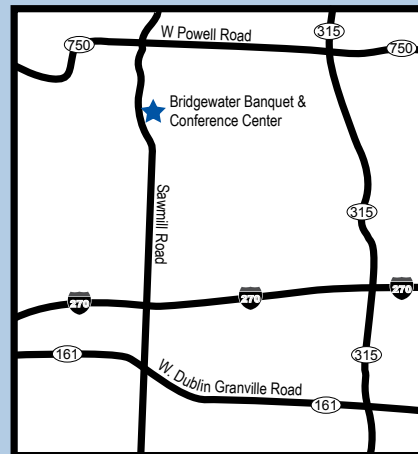
Take I-71 South to I-270 West to the Sawmill Road Exit. Turn right and head North 2.1 miles on Sawmill Road.
