LCBMRDD honors top performer

NEWARK – The Licking County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities (LCBMRDD) recently recognized Robin Wilson of Newark as Staff Member of the Month for July.

Wilson was chosen for this honor based on her ability to multitask as secretary in the Transportation Services department. She communicates with bus and van drivers, answers phones and organizes much of the department's paperwork.

"Robin takes on a lot of responsibility," her nomination states. "She even drives when (the department is) shorthanded."

Wilson lives in Newark and recently celebrated 10 years with the LCBMRDD.

The LCBMRDD provides comprehensive services to more than 1,300 Licking County children and adults with mental retardation and other developmental disabilities. The agency operates early intervention and preschool services at the E.S. Weiant (formerly Starlight) Center in Newark, and the Ann Davino Center in Pataskala. It also oversees adult services at LICCO Inc. in Heath, residential supports, family respite, transportation and service coordination. The LCBMRDD is nationally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for providing high-quality support services to individuals with disabilities and their families.
